


Share of rail in total freight transport 2013, 2022 and 2023 (%, based on tonne-kilometres)



Note: Cyprus and Malta have no railways. Countries are ranked based on 2023 data.



Examples of investment in rail freight in Spain

- approx. €3b for the construction, modernisation and upgrading of rail infrastructure in the Atlantic Corridor and Mediterranean Corridor
- approx. € 500 million to the rolling highway project between Algeciras and Zaragoza
- approx. €35million in EU grants from the Connecting Europe Facility Transport fund (CEF) to the port authority of Valencia to help enhance the infrastructure, improve accessibility and facilitate intermodal transport
