## Swiss Court Pauses Unilateral Wagon Safety Measures, Paving Way for European Collaboration

UIP welcomes the fact that the Swiss Federal Administrative Court has ordered the provisional suspension of the Federal Office of Transport's (FOT) decree imposing unilateral wagon safety measures. The decision, issued on 24 November, reinforces the need for evidence-based safety measures that apply consistently across Europe, preventing further fragmentation of Europe's rail area. The FOT measures issued in September, and amended in October, are therefore not applicable for the duration of the proceedings or until a contrary decision is made.

UIP Secretary General Gilles Peterhans said the following: "Safety is a shared responsibility. The court ruling underscores the need for a collaborative, fact-based approach to improving rail safety. We remain committed to working with the FOT, all European national safety authorities, and sector representatives through the Joint Network Secretariat (JNS). As the pan-European platform bringing together all key rail stakeholders, the JNS enables the approval of proportionate and harmonised measures that make rail freight ever safer across Europe—benefiting Switzerland as well."

This court order comes ahead of the publication of the JNS's updated safety recommendations due by the end of this year. The JNS procedure, of which Switzerland is a party, was established by the European Union Agency for Railways (ERA) and exists specifically to ensure that safety issues are addressed in a timely and consistent manner.

Switzerland has a seat at the JNS alongside EU national safety authorities and sector representatives. The sector representatives range from those responsible for the design, construction, operation and maintenance of the rail system.

Bringing all these actors together is crucial to understanding and avoiding potential unintended consequences. The JNS enables a balanced approach that serves the long-term interest of society.

The court order is now an opportunity for all parties to come together, including Switzerland, and focus on finding a common European solution.
